NARRATIVE: The Toyota Corolla and Ford Edge were parked at the construction zone stop light northbound on the Highway 52 bypass in Jamestown. The GMC Envoy was traveling northbound and failed to slow down or stop for the light. The GMC rear-ended the Ford, pushing it into the west ditch and then rear-ended the Toyota on the rear passenger side. The GMC continued into the east ditch, striking a culvert. The Toyota remained in the northbound lanes. The Toyota was driven from the scene with the driver not being injured. The occupants of the Ford were transported to by ambulance to Jamestown Regional Medical Center for possible injuries. The driver of the GMC was tested and arrested for the above charges. Passengers of the GMC were not transported.

The crash remains under investigation by the North Dakota Highway Patrol.
