FATAL MOTORCYCLE CRASH NEAR TRENTON, ND

What: Fatal Single Vehicle Motorcycle Crash
Where: ND 1806, mile marker 335, 5 miles west of Trenton
When: 3:32 PM Central Time
Road Conditions: Dry, concrete, good summer driving condition
Weather Conditions: Mostly clear sky, 85 degrees, 17 mph winds
Crash Involvement: Motorcycle
Type of Crash: Ran off road/rollover

NARRATIVE:

On 8/20/2022 at approximately 3:32 PM CST, a Harley Davidson motorcycle was northbound on ND 1806, near mile marker 335, approximately 5 miles west of Trenton, ND. The driver of the motorcycle lost control while passing. The motorcycle entered the north ditch and overturned. The driver was ejected off the motorcycle. The driver was pronounced dead at the scene. The driver was not wearing a helmet. The crash is being investigated by the North Dakota Highway Patrol.
