Where: Interstate 94 mm 286 (6 miles west of Valley City)

When: 08/09/2022 at 6:53 P.M.

Road Conditions: Good

Weather Conditions: Sunshine

Crash Involvement: 1 vehicle

Type of Crash: Motorcycle laid down

NARRATIVE: A 2007 Honda motorcycle was traveling eastbound on Interstate 94. The rear tire was punctured causing the male rider to attempt to slow to the shoulder. The male rider lost control causing the Honda motorcycle to be laid down on its side. The male rider was ejected and suffered non-life-threatening injuries. The male was transport by Valley City Ambulance to CHI Mercy Hospital. The crash is under investigation by the North Dakota Highway Patrol.
