## **Steele County Serious Injury Single Vehicle Rollover Crash**

**What:** Injury crash

**Where:** 6<sup>th</sup> Street SE (Steele County Road 5), near the 125<sup>th</sup> Avenue SE intersection, approximately 7 miles west of Hope

**When:** December 6, 2022, at approximately 11:44 PM CST

**Road Conditions:** Lightly snow-covered gravel

**Crash Involvement:** Single vehicle

**Type of Crash:** Rollover

**Agencies Involved:** North Dakota Highway Patrol, Steele County Sheriff's Office, Hope Fire and Rescue, and Hope Ambulance Service

**Vehicle No. 1:** 2005 Chevrolet Silverado  
**Driver No. 1:** Male; 29 years old; Luverne, ND; serious injuries  
**Restraints:** Unrestrained; no airbag deployment  
**Charges:** DUI

**NARRATIVE:** The 2005 Chevrolet Silverado was westbound on 6<sup>th</sup> Street SE (Steele County Road 5), near the 125<sup>th</sup> Avenue SE intersection, when the vehicle left the roadway, entered the south ditch, rolled, and came to rest on the passenger side. The driver was ejected.

The driver was transported to Sanford Medical Center in Fargo by Hope Ambulance Service.

The crash remains under investigation by the North Dakota Highway Patrol.
