I-94 Injury Crash at the Fargo Red River walk over bridge

What: Injury

Where: I-94 East Bound MM 351 (City of Fargo at the Walk Bridge)

When: December 9th, 2022, at 631 PM

Road Conditions: Good

Weather Conditions: Cloudy

Crash Involvement: Vehicle

Type of Crash: Fixed Object

Agencies Involved: NDHP, Fargo PD, Fargo Fire, FM Ambulance

Vehicle No. 1: 2019 Dodge Ram

Driver No. 1: 51-year-old male from Moorhead, MN (Serious Injury)

Restraints: Unknown

Charges: Under Investigation

NARRATIVE:

The Dodge was traveling eastbound on I-94 in the Fargo Metro area. Prior to the University exit the Dodge left the I-94 roadway and entered the south ditch. The Dodge struck both concrete pillars that support the south side of the red river walk over bridge. Significant damage was sustained to the Dodge, and the driver a 51-year-old male from Moorhead, MN sustained serious injuries as a result of the crash.

The driver of the Dodge was transported by Fargo FM Ambulance to the Sanford Hospital. This crash remains under investigation by the NDHP. The NDHP was assisted by the Fargo Police Department, Fargo Fire Department, and FM ambulance.
