## **1 Vehicle Rollover NW of Larimore**

**What:** Injury Crash

**Where:** US 2 MM 325 10 Miles NW of Larimore

**When:** 1/11/2022 @ 1600 PM

**Weather Conditions:** Blowing snow/Icy

**Crash Involvement:** 1 Vehicle

**Type of Crash:** Rollover

**Vehicle No. 1:** 2008 Nissan Titan

**Driver No. 1:** Raeann Vivier, Female, 42 yo, Rolla, ND

**Restraints:** Seatbelt

**Passenger No. 1:** 1 yo juvenile male, Rolla, ND

**Restraints:** Carseat

**Passenger No. 2:** Daniel Parisien, 24 yo male, Rolla, ND, none to minor injuries

**Restraints:** Seatbelt

**Passenger No. 3:** Kirsten Azure 24 yo female, Rolla ND, no injuries

**Restraints:** No seatbelt

**NARRATIVE:** Vivier was coming from Rolla heading to Grand Forks. Vivier was traveling approximately 65 mph in the passing lane, lost control of the vehicle, went through the median, and the vehicle rolled. No passengers of the vehicle were ejected. Vivier was transported by ambulance Altru to be treated for a head injury. The crash remains under investigation by the NDHP.
