Injury Crash on Highway 2 near Niagara, ND

What: Injury

Where: eastbound US Highway 2, approximately 3.5 miles east of Niagara, ND

When: 01/12/2022, approximately 9:00 AM CST

Road Conditions: Frost/Ice-covered

Weather Conditions: Cloudy

Crash Involvement: 1-Vehicle

Type of Crash: Rollover

Agencies Involved: NDHP, Grand Forks County Sheriff's Office, Larimore Ambulance, ND

Department of Transportation

Vehicle No. 1: 2004 Ford Expedition

Driver No. 1: Male; age 74; of Rugby, ND; serious injuries

Restraints: Seat belt in use

Charges: None

Passenger No. 1: Female; age 89; of Rugby, ND; minor injuries

Restraints: Seat belt in use

NARRATIVE: The driver was driving the Ford east on Highway 2. He lost control on frosty/icy road surfaces. The vehicle slid off the roadway into the south ditch where it overturned.

Both occupants were transported by ambulance to Altru Hospital in Grand Forks. Their names are being withheld pending notification of family.

The crash remains under investigation by the Highway Patrol.
