Injury Crash on Highway 2 near Niagara, ND

What: Injury

Where: eastbound US Highway 2, approximately 3.5 miles east of Niagara, ND

When: 01/12/2022, approximately 9:00 AM CST

Road Conditions: Frost/Ice-covered

Weather Conditions: Cloudy

Crash Involvement: 1-Vehicle

Type of Crash: Rollover

Agencies Involved: NDHP, Grand Forks County Sheriff's Office, Larimore Ambulance, ND

Vehicle No. 1: 2004 Ford Expedition

Driver No. 1: John Gustafson; male; age 74; of Rugby, ND; serious injuries

Restraints: Seat belt in use

Passenger No. 1: Laverne Gustafson; female; age 89; of Rugby, ND; minor injuries

Restraints: Seat belt in use

NARRATIVE: John Gustafson was driving the Ford east on Highway 2. He lost control on frosty/icy road surfaces. The vehicle slid off the roadway into the south ditch where it overturned.

Both occupants were transported by ambulance to Altru Hospital in Grand Forks.

The crash remains under investigation by the Highway Patrol.
