## **UPDATED** Single Vehicle Fatality Crash

**What:** Fatal Crash

**Where:** Interstate 94 Exit 221, 8 miles east of Tappen, ND

**When:** 01-16-2021 12:30 a.m.

**Road Conditions:** Scattered ice

**Weather Conditions:** Cloudy, dark

**Type of Crash:** Rollover

**Agencies Involved:** NDHP, Kidder County Sheriff's Department, Kidder County Ambulance

**Vehicle No. 1:** 2013 Ford F150

**Driver No. 1:** Brett Harr, 20 years old, Steele, ND

**Restraints:** No seat belt in use, fatal injuries

**NARRATIVE:** Brett Harr was traveling eastbound on Interstate 94. Harr's vehicle was in the left lane, and he lost control on the scattered ice-covered roadway. His vehicle left the roadway and entered the gore area between the interstate and exit ramp of Exit 221. Harr's vehicle rolled over coming to rest on its roof. Harr was not wearing a seat belt at the time and was fully ejected from the vehicle. Brett Harr was pronounced deceased at the scene.

This crash remains under investigation by the North Dakota Highway Patrol.
