**What:** One vehicle rollover injury crash

**Where:** Highway 22 near mile marker 148, 10 miles North of Mandaree

**When:** Approximately 1000 AM CST

**Road Conditions:** Slick roadways

**Weather Conditions:** Clear, Partly Cloudy

**Agencies Involved:** North Dakota Highway Patrol, Three Affiliated Tribes Police Department  
McKenzie County Sheriff's Office, Mandaree Fire and Ambulance

**Vehicle No. 1:** 2000 Dodge Durango

**No. 1:** Female, 25 years old, Plantation Fl, Minor injuries

**Restraints:** Unrestrained

**Passenger No. 1:** Female, 62 years old, Flushing, NY, Possible serious injuries

**Restraints:** Unrestrained

**NARRATIVE:** The Dodge Durango was traveling north on Hwy 22 near mile marker 148. The driver of the Dodge lost control as it navigated a curve. The Dodge entered the west ditch and rolled. The Dodge came to rest on its passenger side. Both occupants were removed from the vehicle and transported by ambulance to Trinity in Minot, ND. The crash remains under investigation by the North Dakota Highway Patrol.
