1 Vehicle Fatality Crash

What: Fatality

Where: I-94 in Jamestown

When: 1/8/22 at 2:17 PM

Road Conditions: Icy

Weather Conditions: Blowing Snow

Crash Involvement: 1 vehicle

Type of Crash: Roll over

Agencies Involved: NDHP, Jamestown PD, Stutsman County SO, Jamestown FD

Vehicle No. 1: 2001 Ford F-350

Driver No. 1: 69 year old male from Upton, WY. Deceased.

Restraints: seatbelt in use

Charges: none

Passenger No. 1: 26 year old male from Upton, WY. Injured.

Restraints: seatbelt in use

NARRATIVE: The F-350 was eastbound on I-94 after having just entered at exit 258 in Jamestown. The driver lost control and entered the median causing the vehicle to roll over. The vehicle rolled across the westbound lanes and came to rest in the north ditch upright. The driver was pronounced dead on the scene. The passenger was transported to Jamestown Regional Medical Center for non-life-threatening injuries. The crash remains under investigation. The names of the vehicle occupants will be released tomorrow, pending family notification.
