Highway 1806 (North Mandan, ND) - Head-On Crash

What: Injury Crash

Where: Highway 1806 - mile marker 76.5 (North Mandan)

When: 7/1/22 at approximately 2:45 pm (Central Time)

Road Conditions: Good

Weather Conditions: Cloudy

Crash Involvement: Two Vehicles

Type of Crash: Head-on

Agencies Involved: Mandan Police Department, Morton County Sheriff's Department and Metro Ambulance Service

Vehicle No. 1: 2009 Saturn Outlook

Driver No. 1: Zachary Campagna – 21 years old – Mandan, ND – Non-life-threatening injuries

Restraints: Seatbelt not in use. Airbags deployed.

Charges: Under Investigation

Vehicle No. 2: 2012 Ford F-150

Driver No. 2: Terry Millner – 70 years old – Mandan, ND – Minor Injuries

Restraints: Seatbelt used. Airbags deployed.

Charges: Under Investigation

NARRATIVE: The 2009 Saturn driven by Zachary Campagna was traveling northbound on Highway 1806 near mile marker 76.5. The 2012 Ford driven by Terry Millner was traveling southbound on Highway 1806 near mile marker 76.5. The Saturn crossed the center line into

the southbound lane where it struck the Ford head-on. The vehicles came to rest in the southbound lane of the roadway.

The driver of the Saturn was transported by ambulance to Sanford Hospital in Bismarck for non-life-threatening injuries. The driver of the Ford was later transported by personal vehicle for minor injuries.

This crash remains under investigation by the North Dakota Highway Patrol
