Motorcycle Injury Crash near Forest River

What: Injury

Where: Walsh County Road 6 Approximately 5 miles north of Forest River

When: 07/16/2022 @ 12:41 PM CST

Road Conditions: Good/Gravel

Weather Conditions: Sunny

Crash Involvement: 1 vehicle

Type of Crash: Rollover

Agencies Involved: NDHP, Minto Fire Protection District, Walsh County Sheriff's Office, Minto

Vehicle No. 1: 2014 Harley Davidson motorcycle

Driver No. 1: Cory Anderson, male, 43 yo, severe injuries, Grand Forks, ND

Restraints: no helmet

NARRATIVE: Anderson was northbound on County Road 6 riding motorcycle with a group of motorcycle riders. Anderson hit a soft patch of roadway on the gravel road northbound, lost control of the motorcycle, which tipped and rolled over. Anderson was ejected from the motorcycle and was taken to Altru Hospital sustaining severe injuries. The crash remains under investigation by the NDHP.
