Rollover Injury Crash North of Hillsboro

What: Injury

Where: Interstate 29 mm 105 Northbound

When: 07/17/2022 at approximately 1423-hours

Road Conditions: Good/Concrete

Weather Conditions: Clear

Crash Involvement: 1 vehicle

Type of Crash: Rollover

Agencies Involved: NDHP, Traill County Sheriff's Office, Hillsboro Fire and Rescue, Buxton Fire and Rescue, Hillsboro Ambulance Service, Lifeflight

Vehicle No. 1: 2008 Dodge Ram 1500 Pickup

Driver No. 1: Shawn Beebe, 57 year old male; Injuries; Independence, MO

Restraints: no seatbelt

Charges: Under Investigation

NARRATIVE: Beebe was traveling northbound on Interstate 29 mm 105 when his vehicle left the roadway and entered the east ditch. Beebe traveled in the east ditch, struck a delineator post, over corrected to the west and then lost control of the pickup eventually rolling onto it's driver's side in the east ditch. Beebe was partially ejected from the pickup and had to be extricated from the vehicle. Beebe was taken by Hillsboro Ambulance Service to Hillsboro where he was later flown to Altru Hospital in Grand Forks where he is being treated for his injuries. The crash remains under investigation by the NDHP.
