Farm equipment strikes overpass bridges causing property damage

What: Property Crash

Where: US Highway 2, mile marker 355.5, at Grand Forks, ND

When: July 18, 2022, approximately 9:57 AM

Road Conditions: Good

Weather Conditions: Clear

Crash Involvement: Vehicle into overpass bridges

Type of Crash: Fixed object

Agencies Involved: North Dakota Highway Patrol and Grand Forks PD

Vehicle No. 1: 2019 Kenworth truck pulling a chisel plow

Driver No. 1: Kristopher Anderson; male; 45 years of age; of Karlstad, MN; no injuries

Restraints: Seat belt worn

Charges: Operating without oversize permit and violating height restrictions

NARRATIVE: Anderson was driving the 2019 Kenworth pulling a chisel plow east on US Highway 2. The chisel plow struck the overpasses at Grand Forks, ND, as the vehicle traveled underneath. The implement caused damage to both overheads. Anderson was not injured.

The chisel plow exceeded legal height restrictions. The North Dakota Department of Transportation determined the overpasses were not compromised.
