Highway 83 Rollover Injury Crash

What: Injury Crash

Where: Highway 83 MP 105 (7 miles South of Wilton, ND)

When: July 2, 2022, at 2:38 am

Road Conditions: Normal

Weather Conditions: Clear/Dark

Agencies Involved: North Dakota Highway Patrol, Burleigh Cty SO, Wilton Fire Department, Wilton Ambulance, Metro Ambulance

Vehicle No. 1: 2007 Dodge Caliber

Driver No. 1: Titus Covey, 18 years old, Bismarck, Injured

Restraints: Seat belt

Charges: Charges pending

Passenger No. 1: Paul Massingill, 19 years old, Bismarck, Serious Injuries

Restraints: None in use, ejected

NARRATIVE: Titus Covey was traveling southbound on Highway 83 from Hazen to Bismarck. The vehicle ran off the roadway, entered the median and rolled. The passenger, Paul Massingill, was not wearing a seat belt and was fully ejected. Titus was wearing a seat belt at the time of the crash. Both occupants were transported to Sanford hospital in Bismarck.

The crash remains under the investigation by the North Dakota Highway Patrol.
