What: Injury Crash

Where: Highway 2 and 58th St. W (Within Williston city limit)

When: At approximately 1226PM CST

Road Conditions: Good, Dry

Weather Conditions: Cloudy

Crash Involvement: Angle

Type of Crash: Right Angle (T-bone)

Agencies Involved: NDHP, Williston Police Department, Williston Fire Department, Williston Ambulance

Vehicle No. 1: 2002 Kia Sorrento

Driver No. 1: 37 year old, Female, Epping, ND – Seriously Injured

Restraints: Seatbelt in Use

Charges: Pending

Vehicle No. 2: 2017 Ford F-250

Driver No. 2: 51 year old, Female, Williston, ND – Minor injuries

Restraints: Seatbelt in Use

NARRATIVE:

The Ford was stopped at the intersection of Hwy 2 and 58th St W. The Kia was traveling south on Hwy 2. The Ford entered the intersection upon receiving the green signal. The Kia failed to stop at the red light, entered the intersection, and struck the Ford on the driver side. Both vehicles came to rest in the intersection. The driver of the Kia was taken by ambulance to CHI St. Alexius in Williston. The driver of the Ford received minor injuries.

The crash remains under investigation by the North Dakota Highway Patrol.
