

Serious Injury Crash, Fargo

What: Injury crash

Where: 12th Avenue N & Interstate 29, Fargo

When: June 10, 2022 at ~12:00 (noon) CT.

Road Conditions: Good, dry

Weather Conditions: Clear

Crash Involvement: Motorcycle vs. commercial motor vehicle

Type of Crash: Angle

Agencies Involved: Fargo PD, Fargo Fire, Sanford Ambulance

Vehicle No. 1: 2004 Kawasaki Vulcan motorcycle
Driver No. 1: Jordan Schweitzer, 33 yom; Fargo, ND; Serious injuries
Restraints: Helmet not in use
Charges: Crash remains under investigation.

Vehicle No. 2: 2020 International Truck (bobtail)
Driver No. 2: Clark Hamre, 64 yom; Fergus Falls, MN; not injured
Restraints: Seat belt in use.
Charges: Crash remains under investigation.

NARRATIVE: On June 10, 2022 at approximately 12:00 noon, Fargo Police Department requested ND Highway Patrol assistance with a serious injury motorcycle crash that also involved a commercial motor vehicle. Troopers investigated the crash and learned that Schweitzer was operating a motorcycle westbound on 12th Avenue N near Interstate 29. Hamre was operating a bobtail International truck southbound on Interstate 29 and had turned westbound on 12th Avenue N. Schweitzer approached the truck and laid the bike down, sliding into the truck. Schweitzer was not wearing a helmet and sustained serious injuries. The crash remains under investigation by the ND Highway Patrol.
