Motorcycle Fatal Crash – I-94 MM 341 Westbound

What: One vehicle motorcycle crash

Where: I-94 MM 341 westbound

When: June 28th, 2022 at approximately 9:05 pm

Road Conditions: Dry pavement

Weather Conditions: Clear skies, dusk

Type of Crash: Motorcycle lost control, rider thrown from the bike

Agencies Involved: NDHP, Cass County SO, West Fargo Rural FD, Sanford Ambulance

Vehicle No. 1: 2007 Harley Davidson motorcycle

Driver No. 1: 36 YOA male - deceased

Restraints: No helmet

Charges: n/a

NARRATIVE:

The Harley Davidson was westbound on I-94 near MM 341. While traveling westbound, the rider of the motorcycle lost control. The motorcycle began to wobble, and the rider was thrown from the motorcycle. The motorcycle came to rest on the median shoulder.

The 36 YOA male rider was thrown into the median, where he came to rest. Fire and EMS arrived and provided medical treatment, but the male was pronounced dead on scene. The male was not wearing a helmet.

This crash remains under investigation by the North Dakota Highway Patrol.

The rider's name will be released during the evening hours on June 30th.
