McKenzie County Motorcycle Crash

What: Injury

Where: Highway 1806 near mile marker 290, 20 miles north of Watford City, ND.

When: June 5, 2022, at approximately 1036 AM CST

Road Conditions: Good

Weather Conditions: Partly Cloudy

Crash Involvement: One vehicle

Type of Crash: Non Collision

Agencies Involved: North Dakota Highway Patrol, McKenzie County Sheriff's Office, McKenzie County Ambulance, Watford City Rural Fire Department, Keene First Responders, and Trinity NorthStar Criticair.

Vehicle No. 1: 2002 Yamaha XVA

Driver No. 1: Male, 35 years old, Belle Fourche, SD – Serious Injuries

Restraints: No Helmet in use

Passenger No. 1: Female, 13 year old, Belle Fourche, SD – Serious Injuries

Restraints: No Helmet in use

NARRATIVE:

The motorcycle was traveling north on Hwy 1806. The driver stated the motorcycle began experiencing mechanical issues. The driver failed to negotiate the curve, crossed into the other lane, and onto the left shoulder of the roadway. The driver lost control of the motorcycle and tipped. The motorcycle came to rest facing northeast on the left shoulder of the roadway. The juvenile passenger fell from the motorcycle. The male driver's leg was pinned under the motorcycle. The driver and passenger were transported by McKenzie County Ambulance to McKenzie County Hospital. The juvenile passenger was then transported by air to Trinity Hospital in Minot.
