What: Injury

Where: Interstate 94 near mile marker 271.5 (11 miles east of Jamestown)

When: 05/28/2022 at 11:45 A.M.

Road Conditions: Good

Weather Conditions: Sunshine

Crash Involvement: 1 vehicle (semi-tractor and trailer)

Type of Crash: Overturned

Agencies Involved: North Dakota Highway Patrol, Stutsman County Sheriff's Department, Barnes County Sheriff's Department, Sanborn Fire and Rescue, and Barnes County Ambulance.

Vehicle No. 1: 2012 Volvo semi and trailer

Driver No. 1: 67-year-old female, Sparks, NV, Injured

Restraints: Seatbelt in use

Charges: Care Required

NARRATIVE: A 2012 Volvo semi and trailer was traveling west bound on Interstate 94 near mile marker 272. The driver of the Volvo fell asleep causing the semi to enter the median. The driver overcorrected causing the semi to overturn on it's driver side. The semi came to rest across both westbound lanes of Interstate 94. The driver was transported by Barnes County ambulance to CHI Mercy Hospital in Valley City to be treated for her injuries sustained in the crash. The crash caused the westbound lanes of Interstate 94 to be closed for one hour. The crash is under investigation by the North Dakota Highway Patrol.
