

Barnes County CMV Crash

What: Property Crash

Where: Interstate 94 MM 272, 12 Miles East of Jamestown

When: 11-15-2022 4:30 PM

Road Conditions: Ice covered with blowing snow

Weather Conditions: Cloudy/Snowing

Crash Involvement: 1 vehicle

Type of Crash: Ran off Roadway

Agencies Involved: NDHP, Barnes County SO, Valley City Ambulance, Sanborn Fire and Rescue

Vehicle No. 1: 2022 Freight liner semi
Driver No. 1: Habib Mohamud, 36; Minneapolis, MN, possible injury
Restraints: Seatbelt
Charges: Care Required

NARRATIVE: The driver of the Freightliner was eastbound on Interstate 94. The driver lost control of his semi and began traveling from shoulder to shoulder. At the overhead of the interchange at exit 272, the driver traveled south through the guard rail and continued east. The Freightliner scraped down the support pillars on the driver side and the trailer got hung up on the supports. The driver walked away from the crash and was transported to Mercy hospital by ambulance where he was treated and released for minor bruising.

The crash remains under investigation by the North Dakota Highway Patrol.
