NARRATIVE: The motorcycle was traveling eastbound on 40th Avenue S while the SUV turning left to go from 66th Street S to go west on 40th Avenue S. The motorcycle struck the front left corner of the SUV. The rider of the motorcycle was thrown from the

vehicle and landed in the roadway. He was transported to a local hospital for serious, life-threatening injuries. The name of the injured party will be released on November 3. The names of the juvenile driver and passengers will not be released.

The crash remains under investigation by the ND Highway Patrol.
