

## Fargo fatal crash investigation - Update

<b>What:</b>	One-vehicle fatality crash
<b>Where:</b>	3500 Block Westrac Drive, Fargo
<b>When:</b>	1343 hours CT, October 29
<b>Road Conditions:</b>	Dry asphalt, Seasonal
<b>Weather Conditions:</b>	Clear, Sunny, Daylight
<b>Crash Involvement:</b>	Single-vehicle motorcycle crash
<b>Type of Crash:</b>	Roll-over
<b>Agencies Involved:</b>	ND Highway Patrol; Fargo PD; Fargo Fire
<b>Vehicle No. 1:</b>	2000 Yamaha XVS65
<b>Driver No. 1:</b>	Andrew Burt, 38; Byron, MN; Fatal injuries
<b>Restraints:</b>	Helmet not in use
<b>Charges:</b>	None

**NARRATIVE:** The motorcycle left a private parking lot, entering Westrac Drive traveling eastbound and accelerated. The motorcycle lost control and struck a curb, throwing the operator from the motorcycle. The driver of the motorcycle was pronounced dead at the scene. Fargo PD requested ND Highway Patrol assistance with the crash, which remains under investigation by the North Dakota Highway Patrol.
