

Fargo injury crash

What:	Injury crash
Where:	Interstate 29 northbound, mile marker 63 (tri-level interchange)
When:	September 4, 2022 at approximately 1:45 p.m. CT
Road Conditions:	Dry, good
Weather Conditions:	Clear, sunny
Crash Involvement:	Single vehicle
Type of Crash:	Vehicle vs. fixed object
Agencies Involved:	ND Highway Patrol, Fargo Fire Dept., FM Ambulance
Vehicle No. 1:	2008 Acura RDX
Driver No. 1:	68 year old male; Moorhead, MN; Seriously injured
Restraints:	Seat belt not in use

NARRATIVE: On September 4 at approximately 1:45 p.m., the Acura was traveling southbound on the northbound shoulder of Interstate 29 near the tri-level interchange. In this area the median is paved with a raised concrete median barrier, which divides northbound and southbound traffic. At the tri-level interchange, the Acura struck the end of one of the concrete median barriers with the front right of the vehicle. The vehicle came to rest in the west northbound lane, facing west. The driver and sole occupant of the vehicle sustained serious injuries and was transported to a local hospital.

The crash remains under investigation by the ND Highway Patrol. The name of the injured party will be released at a later time.
