Nelson County Two-Vehicle Injury Crash

What: Injury

Where: Intersection of ND Highways 15 and 32, approximately 4 miles north of Aneta

When: September 5, 2022, at approximately 3:44 PM

Road Conditions: Good

Weather Conditions: Dry

Crash Involvement: Two vehicle rollover crash

Type of Crash: Angle/Rollover

Agencies Involved: North Dakota Highway Patrol, Nelson County Sheriff's Office, Aneta Fire & Rescue, Michigan Ambulance Service, McVille Ambulance Service, and Aneta Ambulance Service

Vehicle No. 1: 2020 Subaru Ascent
Driver No. 1: Female; 56 years old; Broomfield, CO; serious injuries
Restraints: Seat belted; airbags deployed
Charges: Failed to yield right of way at intersection marked with stop sign

Vehicle No. 2: 2008 Chevrolet Silverado towing a 2012 ABU dump trailer
Driver No. 2: Male; 31 years old; Larimore, ND; uninjured
Restraints: Unrestrained; airbags deployed
Charges: None

Passenger No. 1: Female; 29 years old; Larimore, ND; serious injuries
Restraints: Unrestrained; airbags deployed

NARRATIVE:

The 2020 Subaru Ascent was eastbound on ND Highway 15, at the stop sign regulated intersection with ND Highway 32. The 2008 Chevrolet Silverado was southbound on ND

Highway 32, pulling a dump trailer. The Subaru entered the intersection, and the left side of the Subaru struck the right front of the Chevrolet coming to rest on its top. The Chevrolet entered the southeast ditch and came to rest upright, while the trailer came to rest on its right side.

The injured parties were transported to Altru Hospital in Grand Forks by McVile and Michigan Ambulance Services.

The crash remains under investigation by the North Dakota Highway Patrol.
