FATAL MOTORCYCLE CRASH

What:	Fatal Crash
Where:	ND-21, mile marker 114, 7 miles east of Flasher
When:	Friday, August 18, 2023 2:17 CDT
Road Conditions:	Good seasonal driving conditions/normal
Weather Conditions:	Clear/Sunny, 12-17 mph winds, 84 degrees
Crash Involvement:	Single vehicle (motorcycle) rollover

NARRATIVE: A 65-year-old Elgin man was driving a 2019 Indian Roadmaster motorcycle west on ND21. The motorcycle drifted off the pavement to the right as the driver was negotiating a curve to the left, near mile marker 114. The motorcycle overturned as it was being maneuvered back onto the pavement. The driver was ejected off the motorcycle and sustained fatal injuries. The driver was not wearing a helmet. The driver was pronounced dead at the scene by the county coroner. This case is under investigation by the North Dakota Highway Patrol.
