Cass County Injury Crash 36th St & 166th Ave SE Mapleton (Cass County Road 10)

What: SUV vs. SUV head on Injury crash

Where: 36th St & 166th Ave SE Mapleton, four miles east of Mapleton

When: August 22nd, 2023 at 3:36PM

Road Conditions: Dry pavement

Weather Conditions: Clear skies.

Crash Involvement: An eastbound Blazer crossed over into the westbound lanes striking an Equinox.

Agencies Involved: Cass County Sheriff's Office, Cass Rescue, Harwood Rescue, Mapleton Fire, West Fargo Fire, Sanford Ambulance, and the ND Highway Patrol.

Vehicle No. 1: 2004 Chevrolet Blazer

Driver No. 1: William Callihan, 42, Browning, Illinois-Injured

Restraints: Under investigation

Charges: Pending investigation

Vehicle No. 2: 2016 Chevrolet Equinox

Driver No. 1: Annika Greany-Stanger, 28, West Fargo -Injured

Restraints: Belted

Charges: None

NARRATIVE:

At 3:36PM a 2016 Chevrolet Equinox was westbound on 36th St SE. At that time a Chevrolet Blazer was eastbound on 36th Street when it crossed over into the westbound lanes striking the Equinox. The Equinox came to rest in the roadway facing southwest. The Blazer left the roadway into the south ditch where it came to rest facing northeast.

William Callihan sustained serious non-life-threatening injuries in the crash. He was treated on scene and transported by Sanford Ambulance to Fargo for continued care.

Annika Greany-Stanger sustained non-life-threatening injuries in the crash. She was treated on scene and transported by Sanford Ambulance to Fargo for continued care.

The crash occurred in a construction zone. Both shoulders of the roadway were closed. The ASN Construction crew were working on a horizontal directional drilling project for the Red River Diversion. The crews were working in the north ditch at the time of the crash and were not involved.

The crash remains under investigation by the ND Highway Patrol.
