Walsh County Single Vehicle Serious Injury Crash

What: Injury

Where: Walsh County Road 12, approximately 2 miles northeast of Park River

When: Saturday, August 26, 2023 at 4:41 PM CDT

Road Conditions: Dry asphalt

Weather Conditions: Clear, sunny

Crash Involvement: Single vehicle

Type of Crash: Non-collision

Agencies Involved: North Dakota Highway Patrol, Walsh County Sheriff's Office, and Park River Ambulance Service

Vehicle No. 1: 2023 Harley Davidson

Driver No. 1: Male; 31 years old; Grafton, ND; Serious injuries

Restraints: No helmet

Charges: Care required

NARRATIVE: The Harley Davidson was northbound on Walsh County Road 12, approximately 2 miles northwest of Park River. The driver failed to negotiate a curve in the roadway and the Harley Davidson entered the east ditch, tripped, and the driver was ejected, sustaining serious injuries. The driver was transported First Care Health Center in Park River by the Park River Ambulance Service.

The crash remains under investigation by the North Dakota Highway Patrol.
