## **UPDATE**Single-Vehicle Crash

**Crash Involvement:** Single Vehicle Crash

Type of Crash: Non-Collision/Fixed Object

Agencies Involved: North Dakota Highway Patrol, Emmons County Sheriff's Office, Strasburg

Fire and Rescue, Strasburg First Responders, Linton Ambulance and Sanford Airmed.

**Vehicle No. 1:** 2015 Chevrolet Silverado

**Driver No. 1:** SCOTTI SCHERR, 27-year-old male, Linton, serious injuries

**Restraints:** Not in Use

Charges: Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol/Care Required

**NARRATIVE:** Driver was traveling westbound on 89<sup>th</sup> Street SE just west of 2<sup>nd</sup> Ave SE in Strasburg. He lost control of his vehicle and entered the north ditch. He struck two box culverts and numerous fence posts. He was not seat belted and he sustained serious injuries and was transported, via Sanford Airmed, to Sanford Hospital in Bismarck, ND. Alcohol was a factor in the crash. Crash remains under investigation by the Highway Patrol.
