Pedestrian Struck by Vehicle

What: Two Vehicle Pedestrian Injury Crash

Where: 5 Miles East of Northwood ND

When: December 31, 2022 8:06 p.m.

Road Conditions: Icy from foggy conditions

Weather Conditions: Dense Fog

Crash Involvement: Vehicle vs Pedestrian

NARRATIVE: The Cadillac driven by Lloyd was traveling westbound on highway 15 approximately 5 miles east of Northwood ND. Conditions were icy with dense fog. The Chevrolet driven by Sherod was attempting to pull a third vehicle stuck in the north ditch that had earlier been driven by Nolden. Nolden was now a pedestrian standing outside of his stuck vehicle. The Chevrolet was facing the wrong way on Highway 15 in the traffic lane. Lloyd swerved right attempting to avoid striking the Chevrolet. Lloyd struck the Chevrolet with her Cadillac, glanced off and then struck Nolden the pedestrian. This crash remains under investigation.
