Vehicle Pursuits Bismarck/Mandan

NARRATIVE:

7/13/2023 at 3:05 PM

A motorcycle, driven by 33-year-old male Rolando Carreno of Mandan, fled from Bismarck Police Department after officers tried to initiate a traffic stop. Officers did not pursue. ND Highway Patrol had their department aircraft in the air at the time and located the motorcycle driving recklessly and at a high rate of speed into the city of Mandan. Aircraft tracked the motorcycle while troopers stayed near by to wait for Carreno to park. Carreno parked his motorcycle at a local hotel in Mandan. Troopers converged on Carreno and he was taken into custody after he had gotten into another vehicle. Carreno was arrested and taken to Burleigh Morton County Detention Center. He is being charged with fleeing a police officer, reckless endangerment, and false information to a police officer by Bismarck PD. He gave a false name to officers.

7/14/2023 at 2:50 PM

Highway Patrol Trooper was traveling through the city of Bismarck at Expressway and University Dr. He observed a car make an improper lane change and cut other vehicles off. Trooper activated his emergency light to initiate a traffic stop. Vehicle fled southbound on University Dr towards the airport at a high rate of speed. Trooper pursued. The vehicle reached speeds in excess of 80 mph in the 35-mph zone while driving southbound in the northbound lanes. Vehicle crashed into a light pole a short time later near University Dr. and Wachter Ave. Driver, 26-year-old female Latricia Bravel Bull of Solen, was taken into custody. She was taken to Burleigh Morton County Detention Center on charges of fleeing a police officer, reckless endangerment, Driving Under Revocation, and Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol. Passenger of vehicle was transported to Sanford Hospital for minor injuries.
