## **Minot Injury Crash**

What: Injury

Where: At the intersection of 3<sup>rd</sup> St SE and Burdick Expressway in Minot, ND

When: July 27,2023 at approximately 0448 PM CST

**Road Conditions: Good** 

**Weather Conditions:** Sunny

**Crash Involvement:** Two Vehicle

**Type of Crash:** Angle

Agencies Involved: North Dakota Highway Patrol, Minot Police Department, Ward County

Vehicle No. 1: 2015 Ford F-250

Driver No. 1: Male, 63, Douglas, ND - Uninjured

**Restraints:** Seatbelt in Use

**Charges:** Failed to yield to an emergency vehicle

**Vehicle No. 2:** 2022 Ford Explorer

**Driver No. 2:** Female, 31, Minot, ND - Minor injuries

**Restraints:** Seatbelt in Use

Charges: none

**NARRATIVE:** The F-250 was turning left to travel northbound on 3<sup>rd</sup> St SE. The Explorer, a Minot Police Department patrol vehicle, was traveling eastbound with emergency lights and sirens activated responding to an emergency call. As the Explorer entered the intersection the F-250 turned left into the Explorer striking it on the passenger side. Both vehicles came to a rest in the northeast corner of the intersection.



The crash remains under investigation of the North Dakota Highway Patrol.
