Update JRMU Escapee Presumed Dangerous *Captured*

NARRATIVE:

On July 18th, 2023 at 9:45PM Nathan Allen Lang, 39 years old, escaped from the James River Minimum Unit in Jamestown, ND. He was serving a sentence for theft of property and contributing to the delinquency of a minor. He was last seen wearing a grey long sleeve shirt with a navy blue t-shirt over the top. He was wearing khaki pants and black shoes.

Nathan was last seen on July 18th at 11:53PM driving westbound on the Frontage Road near Exit 256 in Jamestown. Nathan is possibly driving a stolen white 2021 Ram 3500 pickup North Dakota license plate 320AAT. The pickup had an attached 32' goose neck trailer ND license plate T42454.

On the evening of July 28th around 9:00PM the Corson County Sheriff's Office in South Dakota received a tip from a citizen regarding Nathan Lang's whereabouts. The Corson County Sheriff's Office followed up and located Lang in an abandoned farmyard on State Line Road five miles east of South Dakota Highway 63. A pursuit was initiated and continued into a nearby hayfield. Nathan Lang stopped the vehicle and was arrested without incident.



His girlfriend Yorishia Hoon and 2-year-old child were also located in the pickup. The stolen trailer was not attached at the time of the pursuit. Both the truck and trailer have been recovered.

Charges:

Nathan Lang:

Burglary, theft, possession of stolen property, trespassing, eluding, and child neglect.

Yorishia Hoon:

Burglary, theft, possession of stolen property, trespassing, eluding, and child neglect.

The 2-year-old was placed in the care of Child Protective Services. The child's name will not be released.
