Highway 6 DUI Injury Crash

What: Injury

Where: Hwy 6 and County Rd 137(10 miles south of Mandan)

When: 6/6/2023 at 7:04 PM

Driver No. 1: Bradley Hoines, 60-year-old male, Bismarck, no injury

Restraints: seatbelt in use

Vehicle No. 2: 1996 Chevrolet Suburban

Driver No. 2: Jamie Gohl, 43-year old male, Solen, no injury

Restraints: seatbelt in use

Charges: Driving Under the Influence with minor present, Driving Under Suspension

Passenger No. 1: Lauren Derrick, 34-year-old female, Solen, no injury

Restraints: seatbelt in use

Passenger No. 2: 16-year-old male, Solen, minor injury

Restraints: seatbelt in use

Passenger No. 3: 13-year-old female, Solen, minor injury

Restraints: no seatbelt

NARRATIVE: Vehicle 1, driven by Jamie Gohl, was traveling northbound on Highway 6 following Vehicle 2, driven by Bradley Hoines. Hoines started to turn left to go west on County Rd 137 after activating his turn signal. Gohl was following too close. He braked and swerved left into the southbound lane to avoid Hoines' vehicle. Gohl struck the front driver side of Hoine's trailer with the front of his suburban. Both units came to rest on County Rd 137. 2 juvenile passengers were transported to Sanford in Bismarck for minor injuries. Gohl was arrested for Driving under Suspension and Driving Under the Influence with minor present. He was taken into custody and taken to Burleigh Morton County Detention Center. Crash is still under investigation.
