What: Injury

Where: Interstate 94 mm 241 (15 miles west of Jamestown)

When: 3/05/2023 at 5:45 P.M. Central Time

Road Conditions: Ice covered.

Weather Conditions: Blowing snow.

Crash Involvement: One vehicle

Type of Crash: Rollover

Agencies Involved: North Dakota Highway Patrol, Stutsman County Sheriff's Department, Medina Ambulance, Medina Fire, and Cleveland Fire.

Vehicle No. 1: 2003 Toyota Camry

Driver No. 1: 23-year-old female, Jamestown, ND, non-life-threatening injuries

Restraints: Seatbelt in use

Charges: Care Required, driving without liability insurance

Passenger No. 1: Juvenile female, non-life-threatening injuries

Restraints: Seatbelt in use

NARRATIVE: A Toyota Camry was traveling westbound on Interstate 94 west of Jamestown. The female driver was traveling too fast for conditions and lost control causing the Camry to enter the north ditch. The Camry overturned and came to rest on its roof facing North. The driver and passenger were transported by Medina Ambulance to Jamestown Regional Medical Center to be treated for their injuries sustained in the crash. The crash is under investigation by the North Dakota Highway Patrol.
