NARRATIVE: The Chevrolet, driven by Contreras, was eastbound on $47^{\text {th }}$ Ave S , at the railroad crossing on the 5500 Block, approximately 1 mile west of Interstate 29. An Amtrak train was northbound on the tracks. The Chevrolet struck the front side of the lead engine. The vehicle came to rest on the west side of the crossing. The driver sustained injuries in the crash and was transported from the scene by ambulance. The crash remains under investigation by the NDHP.
