## **Stutsman County Serious Injury Crash**

**What:** Injury

**Where:** Intersection of Highway 281 and Highway 46

**When:** 05/26/2023 at 5:30 P.M. Central Time

**Road Conditions:** Good

**Weather Conditions:** Daylight

**Crash Involvement:** 2 vehicle crash

**Type of Crash:** Angle

**Agencies Involved:** North Dakota Highway Patrol, Stutsman County Sheriff's Department, Jamestown Ambulance, and Jamestown Rural Fire Department.

**Vehicle No. 1:** 2010 Ford Fusion

**Driver No. 1:** 17-year-old male, Jamestown, ND, Serious injury

**Restraints:** Seatbelt not in use

**Charges:** Under investigation

**Vehicle No. 2:** 2010 Chevrolet Silverado

**Driver No. 2:** 18-year-old male, Jamestown, ND, Minor injury

**Restraints:** Seatbelt in use

**Charges:** Failure to yield to right of way

**NARRATIVE:** A 2010 Ford Fusion was traveling northbound on Highway 281 near the intersection of Highway 46. A 2010 Chevrolet was located on the west side of the intersection of Highway 281 and Highway 46. The male driver of the Chevrolet Silverado failed to yield to the right of way when traveling eastbound across the intersection. This caused the Ford Fusion to strike the Chevrolet in the front passenger side. The Chevrolet Silverado then entered the Northeast ditch and struck a powerline pole coming to rest facing North East. The Ford Fusion then came to rest in the Northeast part of the intersection facing Southwest.

Both male drivers were transported to Jamestown Regional Medical Center to be treated for their injuries sustained in the crash. The crash is under investigation by the North Dakota Highway Patrol.
