Hit and Run Injury Crash – Wahpeton Seeking Public Assistance

On October 12th, 2023, at approximately 7:40 pm, a vehicle vs pedestrian serious injury crash occurred in the 400 block of 11th Ave S in Wahpeton, ND, which is on the north side of the Wahpeton Airport.

A dark colored, ¾ - 1 ton pickup with a loud exhaust was traveling eastbound on 11th Ave S when the pickup struck a female pedestrian that was walking along the south side of the roadway. The pick-up then fled the scene, traveling eastbound on 11th Ave S and then turned northbound on one of the streets to the east of the crash scene (4th, 3rd, 2nd or 1st St S or 182nd Ave SE).

The dark colored pickup will have damage to the front passenger side of the vehicle, and possibly windshield damage.

The female pedestrian suffered life threatening injuries.

The Wahpeton Police Department, Richland County Sheriff's Office and the ND Highway Patrol (NDHP) responded to the crash scene and are continuing to investigate the crash.

Collectively, we are seeking assistance from the public to assist with locating the suspect vehicle and suspect driver involved in this crash. Specifically, law enforcement is looking for the following:

- Any video from residences in the area of the crash and in the direction the vehicle fled.
- Any videos from businesses in the area of the crash and in the direction the vehicle fled.
- Anyone that can identify the vehicle or suspect in this incident.
