Vehicle No. 2: Mark Berger, 2017 Peterbilt Semi-Truck **Driver No. 2:** 50-year-old male from Ft. Rice, no injuries

Restraints: Seatbelt in use **Charges:** No charges filed

NARRATIVE: 2008 Toyota Corolla was traveling southbound on Highway 1806 when it crossed over the centerline into the northbound lane. Peterbilt Semi Truck and trailer was traveling northbound. Toyota Corolla struck the semi head on. Corolla came to rest in the west ditch. Semi came to rest in the northbound lane. Driver of Toyota Corolla was extricated from the vehicle and transported to Sanford Hospital for serious life-threatening injuries. Driver of semi-truck was not injured. Crash remains under investigation. Name of injured driver will be released at a later date.
