Cass County DUI Injury Crash- State Highway 46 & 159th Ave SE

What: One vehicle rollover injury crash

Where: State Highway 46 & 159th Ave SE - 6 miles Southwest of Kindred

When: September 10th, 2023 at 4:04PM CST

Weather Conditions: Partly Cloudy

Crash Involvement: Yamaha PW80 rollover

Agencies Involved: Kindred Fire, Kindred Ambulance, Sanford Ambulance, Cass County Sheriff's Office, and the ND Highway Patrol

Vehicle No. 1: 2001 PW80 dirt bike

Driver No. 1: Tory Christianson-32, Fargo, ND- Injured

Restraints: No helmet

Charges: Driving Under the Influence

NARRATIVE:

At 4:04 pm, Tory Christianson was driving a 2001 Yamaha TW80 dirt bike westbound in the south ditch of Highway 32. Tory Christianson drove over a field approach, lost control, and was ejected.

Tory Christianson was treated on scene for his serious but non-life-threatening injuries by the Kindred Ambulance. Sanford Ambulance completed the transfer to the Sanford Medical Center in Fargo for continued care.

Tory Christianson was not wearing a helmet in the crash. He was also arrested and charged with Driving Under the Influence.

The crash remains under investigation by the ND Highway Patrol.
