**NARRATIVE:** Schall was traveling westbound on US Highway 2 and the juvenile male, who was originally traveling eastbound on US Highway 2, slowed, and turned north onto 63<sup>rd</sup> Street NE. The juvenile female passenger who was seated on the passenger side front seat was leaning forward at the time which obstructed the driver's view of westbound traffic. The juvenile male completed his turn and traveled north to cross the westbound lanes of traffic

and was struck. Schall was transported by ambulance to CHI Saint Alexius Hospital in Devils Lake for injuries sustained in the crash. Neither juvenile was injured, and their names will not be released.
