NARRATIVE: Vehicle 1 was merging from US Highway 52 southbound onto US Highway 2 westbound when Vehicle 2, a northbound vehicle, failed to yield at the intersection of Ward County 13 and US Highway 2. Vehicle 1 overturned and entered the north ditch and came to rest on its roof. Vehicle 2 came to rest in the north ditch on its tires. The occupants of vehicle 2 were transported to Trinity Hospital in Minot, ND with suspected serious injuries.

The crash remains under investigation by the North Dakota Highway Patrol. The names of the juveniles will not be released.
