What: Serious Injury

Where: 142nd Ave NW and 17th Street NW, approximately 13 miles SW of Arnegard

When: August 13, 2024, 6:13 PM CT

Road Conditions: Good, Gravel

Weather Conditions: Partly Cloudy

Crash Involvement: Single Vehicle

Type of Crash: Rollover

Agencies Involved: NDHP, McKenzie County Sheriff's Office, Arnegard Fire Department, McKenzie County Ambulance

Vehicle No. 1: 2013 Kenworth Truck

Driver No. 1: Conner Gravley, 29-year-old male, El Paso, TX, **Serious Injuries**

Restraints: Seatbelt Not Used

Charges: Under Investigation

NARRATIVE: A 2013 Kenworth semi pulling a side dump trailer loaded with scoria was driving north on 142nd Ave NW near 17th Street NW in McKenzie County. The Kenworth left the roadway and began to enter the east ditch. The driver began to overcorrect to keep the Kenworth on the roadway. The Kenworth overturned and came to rest on its roof in the east ditch of 142nd Ave NW. The driver, Conner Gravley from El Paso, TX, was seriously injured. Gravley was transported to the McKenzie County Health in Watford City and later flown to Trinity Health in Minot. The crash remains under investigation by the NDHP.
