LaMoure County UTV Injury/DUI crash

What: Injury Crash

Where: Field in LaMoure County south of 57th St SE, 1.5 miles east of State Highway 1, approximately 8 miles southwest of Kathryn.

When: 8-17-24 4:22 PM CST

Road Conditions: Muddy field

Weather Conditions: Sunny

Crash Involvement: UTV

Type of Crash: Rollover

Restraints: Seatbelt not in use

NARRATIVE:

Hatlewick was driving the UTV in a muddy field approximately 8 miles southwest of Kathryn when he lost control and it overturned, coming to rest on its top. Hatlewick was not transported by EMS. Winson was transported to Mercy Hospital in Valley City by Barnes County Ambulance for serious, non-life-threatening injuries. Hatlewick was charged with DUI and Criminal Vehicular Injury. The crash remains under investigation by the North Dakota Highway Patrol.
