CORRECTED: Traill County Interstate 29 Rear-end Injury Crash

What: Injury

Where: Interstate 29, northbound, at mile marker 120; approximately 2 miles north of Buxton

When: August 18, 2024; at approximately 11:22 AM CDT

Road Conditions: Good

Weather Conditions: Sunny

Crash Involvement: Vehicle/Vehicle

Type of Crash: Rear-end

Agencies Involved: North Dakota Highway Patrol, Traill County Sheriff's Office, Reynolds Fire Department, Hillsboro Ambulance Service, and Altru Ambulance Service

Vehicle No. 1: 2012 Hyundai Sante Fe
Driver No. 1: Male; 24 years old; Reynolds, ND; uninjured
Restraints: Seatbelt worn and airbags deployed
Charges: Pending

Passenger No. 1: Female; 19 years old; Hope, ND; injured
Restraints: Seatbelt worn and airbags deployed

Vehicle No. 2: 2000 Chevrolet Prism
Driver No. 2: Female; 29 years old; Grand Forks, ND; injured
Restraints: Seatbelt worn

NARRATIVE:

The Chevrolet and Hyundai were northbound in the right lane of Interstate 29, near mile marker 120. The Hyundai struck the rear of the Chevrolet and came to rest on the right shoulder facing north. The Chevrolet came to rest in the median facing southwest.

The driver of the Chevrolet and passenger of the Hyundai were transported to Altru Hospital in Grand Forks.

The crash remains under investigation by the North Dakota Highway Patrol.
