UPDATE: Grand Forks County Two-vehicle Rear-end Injury Crash Near Thompson

What: Injury

Where: 11th Street NE, near the intersection of 7th Avenue NE, approximately 2 miles east of

NARRATIVE:

The Hino was northbound on 11th Street NE, commonly referred to as Grand Forks County Road 81, south of the intersection of 7th Avenue NE, where it was slowing to turn left, westbound. The Western Star was northbound, behind the Hino. The Western Star struck the rear of the Hino and ran off the roadway into the east ditch, where it tipped on its right side. The Hino rotated, crossed the centerline, and came to rest facing south, near the southbound right turn lane.

The injured occupants were transported to Altru Hospital in Grand Forks.
