Highway 83 ATV Injury Crash

What: Injury Crash

Where: Highway 83 mm 94, north of Bismarck, ND

When: August 24, 2024, at approximately 8:31 pm CT

Road Conditions: Good

Weather Conditions: Clear conditions, light breeze

Crash Involvement: ATV

Type of Crash: Rollover

Agencies Involved: Burleigh County SO, Metro Ambulance, Metro Fire, North Dakota Highway Patrol

Vehicle No. 1: 2022 Can Am Defender

Driver No. 1: Bryce Weisbeck, male, 43 years old, Bismarck, ND serious non-life threatening injury

Restraints: none

Charges: DUI with a minor

Passenger No. 1: Female, 7, Bismarck, ND, minor injury

Restraints: none

Passenger No. 2: Male, 9, Bismarck, ND, serious non-life threatening injury

Restraints: none

NARRATIVE: A 2022 Can Am Defender was driving south in the west ditch of US Highway 83 near mile marker 94. For an unknown reason, the driver, Bryce Weisbeck overcorrected the vehicle, resulting in the vehicle overturning in the west ditch. The driver and a juvenile male were ejected from the vehicle. A third passenger, a juvenile female, was not ejected from the vehicle. Weisbeck and the juvenile male suffered serious non-life-threatening injuries. Both were transported to Sanford Bismarck. No seat belts or helmets were worn during the crash. The names of the juveniles will not be released.

This crash remains under investigation by the North Dakota Highway Patrol
