NARRATIVE:

The Dodge and Jeep were southbound in the left lane on Interstate 29, entering a construction zone. As the Dodge slowed, the Jeep struck the rear of it. The Dodge came to rest on the shoulder facing south. The Jeep come to rest on the shoulder facing southwest.

The driver of the Jeep was transported to the Sanford Hillsboro Medical Center by the Hillsboro Ambulance Service.

The crash remains under investigation by the North Dakota Highway Patrol.
