Stutsman County DUI injury crash

What: One vehicle DUI injury crash

Where: Westbound 5300 blk of 34th St SE (2 miles Northwest of Medina, ND)

When: August 31st, 2024 at 1:00 P.M. Central Time

Road Conditions: Dry gravel

Weather Conditions: Clear

Crash Involvement: Vehicle left the roadway entering slough

Agencies Involved: North Dakota Highway Patrol, Stutsman County Sheriff's Office, and Jamestown Ambulance

Vehicle No. 1: 2006 Chevrolet Impala

Driver No. 1: Charmin Knobel-Sayler, 48, Carrington, ND – injured

Restraints: Airbag, unknown restraint

Charges: Driving under the influence, DUI-Refusal, Simple Assault

Narrative:

The Chevrolet Impala driven by Charmin was westbound on 34th St SE. Charmin drove off the road into a slough. The vehicle came to rest in the slough on the south side of the road facing southwest.

Charmin was treated on scene for minor injuries before being transported to the Jamestown Regional Medical Center by the Jamestown Ambulance. While at JRMC, Charmin assaulted emergency department workers.

Charmin was arrested and charged with Driving Under the Influence, DUI refusal, and simple assault- emergency department worker.

The crash remains under investigation by the North Dakota Highway Patrol.
